We are hoping that more of the distancing guidelines will have been relaxed by the time INTER-BAY arrives; we have another eleven weeks to go ...

We are, however, having ongoing detailed conversations as to how we run Inter-BAY appropriately, and responsibly.

We are limiting the number of participants on INTER-BAY, and we will be opening up the rehearsal studio to give us a larger working space; this will give us double the space with fewer singers. Daily warm up, work on vocal technique, and quick learn material will all happen outdoors with appropriate distancing measures.

Music will be handed out at the beginning of the week and participants will be responsible for their music, and pencil, for the remainder of the course. The use of electronic tablets is encouraged, please advise us if this is an option for you and we will email you the music prior to course commencement. Hand sanitiser will be available at all times, and PAC will be cleaned on a daily basis.

All participants are expected to bring their own named water bottle, and food for the day. All food will be consumed outside on the PAC lawn.

We understand that games are an important part of BAY - both in their educational, and bonding capacities. We will be playing games but there will be some 'variations' this year to adhere to Government guidelines.
