We are hoping that more of the distancing guidelines will have been relaxed by the time BAY - EXTRA arrives; we have another twelve weeks to go ...

We are, however, having ongoing detailed conversations as to how we run BAY - EXTRA appropriately, and responsibly.

We are limiting the number of participants on BAY - EXTRA, and we will be opening up the rehearsal studio to give us a larger working space; this will give us double the space with fewer singers. Daily warm up, work on vocal technique, and quick learn material will all happen outdoors with appropriate distancing measures.

There will be no hard copy music, or pencils, handed out for this two day workshop. Instead, we'll work aurally with warm ups, quick learn material, vocal technique, rounds, part songs & ear training games. Hand sanitiser will be available at all times, and PAC will be cleaned in preparation for, and during, both days.

All participants are expected to bring their own named water bottle, and food for the day. All food will be consumed outside on the PAC lawn.

We understand that games are an important part of BAY - both in their educational, and bonding capacities. We will be playing games but there will be some 'variations' this year to adhere to Government guidelines.

There will be no final performance at the end of this two day workshop. BAY - EXTRA is designed to bring our young singers together; to stretch out the voice and have loads of fun along the way.
